cut twine 24-30
cm long. wind one
end around the
bottom of the
back balloon
and tie it
off. then tie the
other end
around the back
arm of the bear.

7

cut twine 12-16
cm long. poke
holes in the center
fold of the card.
thread the twine
through them in
a loop. now,
you can hang
it up or print
out more and
make a garland
out of them.

on the card and

* print out several
& string them
together vertically.
then hang them up
on wall or hook.
